Data protection notice

1. Subject matter of this data protection notice

The following data protection notices apply to all designers, that intend to register for the call for entries of the UNCOVER DESIGN AWARD 2018. For registration and participation within the UNCOVER DESIGN AWARD 2018, we require personal information. Therefor we wish to inform you, in detail, about which information we require, how this information is dealt with and when the information will be deleted.

2. Entity responsible for processing

The entity responsible for processing the data, as laid down in the Datenschutz-Grundverordnung (DSGVO) and the German Data Protection Act (BDSG) for gathering, processing and use of your personal information (hereinafter: processing) is:

3. Processing of your personal information

I. When registering for the call for entries of the UNCOVER DESIGN AWARD 2018, the following information (*) is required:

Personal details

- first name*
- last name*
- User participates as...* (Selection: student / member of a company / owner of a business / freelance creative / other)
For „other“ an indication is required in a blank field.

- name of company/university*
- email address*
- address* (street, street number, ZIP code, city)

Submitted works

- title of the works*
- year of origin* (selection: 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018)
- short project summary* (800 characters)

The project summary must fulfill following guidelines:

- digital format
- multipage PDF file (maximum file size: 10 MB)

The project summary must contain the following information about the participant:

1. a written description of the project
2. including a recommended form of presentation in the case of nomination/exhibition,
3. a poster depicting the project, for presentation of the project at the design exhibition,
4. a short c.v. of the participant and
5. the participants contact information

Specification regarding the category for which the works are submitted* selection:

II. Further handling of personal information

We wish to protect your privacy as far as possible and necessary. So, unless you voluntarily choose to provide your consent, we will not publish the following information:

Address (street, street number, ZIP code, city), email address, website, phone number, name of your company/university.

All further personal information you have provided in the course of registration (see above), will publish digitally/online, as well as in printed form. (for example on: uncover-mannheim.de, Facebook, Instagram, Magazin etc.). Submitted works and the other information regarding the award winners will be published within the framework of the UNCOVER Design Festival, in both print and digital formats, to a public audience.

III. Removal of personal information

After any follow-up processing regarding the UNCOVER Design Festival, all personal data will be deleted. This will likely be the case around the end of 2018. Exceptions to this are any publications published beforehand, such as post on uncover-mannheim.de, Facebook, Instagram or articles in magazines, etc. Another exception regards information we are legally required to keep on file.

4. Legal basis and the purposes of the processing

I. Any personal information is largely processed by us to be able to carry out the call for entries of the UNCOVER DESIGN AWARD 2018 and related measures, such as presentations and the award ceremony.

Legal basis for processing is Art. 6 (1).b DSGVO and § 28 (1).1) BDSG; the processing of this information is necessary to be able carry out the call for entries.

II. Some of your personal information will also be further processed and also forwarded to third parties (see also: 5), to be able to present your works and person to the public; this also gives the award presenters public exposure. Legal basis for processing is Art. 6 (1).f) DSGVO and § 28 (1).2) BDSG; the processing of this information is necessary for us, as well as for the award presenters, to achieve the legitimate interests in a sufficient public exposure of the call for entries. As your participation in the call for entries is voluntary, as well as leaving your personal information – thus public exposure lies also within your own interests – we feel, after careful consideration of both your fundamental right to protection of your data, on the one hand, and our interest in public exposure, on the other, that in this case our interests prevail.

5. Transfer of your personal information to third parties

The personal information of the award winners (in all 5 categories) will be transferred to third parties for publishing (for example on Facebook, in blogs and magazines of our media partners). The information relevant in this case is: name, project title, project pictures, the project description, and if specifically requested by the award winner, also contact information such as email address and website. any other information will not be given to third parties, unless you have consented to a transfer of such information, or we are required by law to give out the information. Such instances may include: law enforcement purposes, hazard prevention or means to enforce intellectual property rights.

6. Legal rights
